

Selection criteria for appointing Honorary Members

IACM Constitution:

3. 6. Honorary members: This category is open to distinguished persons in the field of Computational Mechanics at an international level. Honorary members of IACM will be appointed by the Executive Council. The appointment of honorary members will have no limit of tenure. Honorary members will be permanent members of the General Council and they can take part as guests in meetings of the Executive Council.”

Nomination requirements

In order to attain to the honorary membership, an individual must be promoted by at least 10 regular members of IACM and the IACM Executive Council must award the membership unanimously.

Nominations must include a complete CV of the candidate and a completed nomination form (annex to this document).

Nominations can be submitted at any time to the IACM Secretary-General and will be discussed at the following IACM Executive Council meeting.

Selection criteria

- Outstanding contribution and/or innovation to the computational mechanics and related disciplines
- Outstanding managerial skills that have had an impact in the industry of computational mechanics and benefits to the IACM society
- An outstanding career in science which has had crucial consequences to the fields of interest to the IACM
- Major accomplishments in other scientific disciplines of significant beneficial consequences to mankind
